HCHS SBDM Policy for granting World Language credit earned through alternative methods and for English language learners who are already Proficient in a second language for Program Review.

POLICY STATEMENT

In order to meet the Global Competency/World Languages Program Review requirement, Harlan County High School will offer the ability for credit to be earned through alternative methods for World Languages coursework requirements in the following manners:

Students who have demonstrated proficient through a designated proficiency test will be granted credit based upon their scores/ratings on the proficiency assessments. Designated proficiency exams shall include, but are not limited to, the following:


- The American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) AAPPL Exam
- The STAMP Proficiency Assessment
- The American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) Oral Proficiency Interview

This must be documented by:

- Assessment rating from above exams
- Documentation on the Student's transcript that credit has been granted through alternative methods.

Students who are English Language Learners may also opt to participate in the alternative credit method to demonstrate their proficiency in their first language.

These evidence items will be kept on file with all evidence for Global Competency/World Languages Program Review, as well as in the student's permanent school record.
