WHY do students take the Career and Technical Education End of Program (EOP) assessment? Any students that show at least two credits on their transcript within a Career and Technical Education Pathway (<u>http://harlan.k12.ky.us/CTE.html</u>) are defined as a 'concentrator' and qualify to take a related EOP (End of Program) assessment. Senior concentrator students MUST test; Junior and Sophomore students have the option, but should test if ready and will provide multiple opportunities to pass.

HOW does it benefit students? Students who pass the EOP in any of the CTE Pathways at Harlan County High School earn articulated credit at a number of Colleges and Universities. DO the test results impact the school in any way? YES! Career and Technical Education End-of-

<u>Program (CTE EOP) Assessment for Articulated Credit</u> is one measure of career readiness as a postsecondary readiness indicator for Kentucky's accountability system and one measure of a postsecondary credential for Federal Perkins accountability and funding. This assessment is a factor in the overall accountability for Harlan County High School if students have not attained career readiness through another measure.

- HCHS's 54% total pass rate is an increase of 2% over 2023 and their 2nd highest based on available data (55% in 2018).
- 46 is the highest number of students to pass the EOP at HCHS and earn articulated credit! (<u>https://education.ky.gov/CTE/ArtAgree/Pages/Art_Agree-EOP.aspx</u>).
- Marketing had the largest increase going from a 42% pass rate in 2023 to 68% in 2024! This is the highest pass rate percentage ever for Marketing. Their previous highest was 58% in 2018.

- HCHS's 52% pass rate is an increase of 3% over 2022 and their 2nd highest based on available data (55% in 2018).
- 33 is the 2nd highest number of students to pass the EOP at HCHS and earn articulated credit (<u>https://education.ky.gov/CTE/ArtAgree/Pages/Art_Agree-EOP.aspx</u>).
- Horticulture had the largest increase going from a 14% pass rate in 2022 to 63% in 2023!
- Mechanical Engineering again had the highest total pass rate going from 75% in 2022 to 89% in 2023!
- Marketing only dropped 1% from 2022 and had the most students to test and pass as a whole!
- Culinary had a decrease of 27% from 2022.
- Web Development and Administration had a decrease of 20% from 2022.

- Three out of our five programs met or exceeded the state EOP Assessment state average: Culinary and Food Services, Mechanical Engineering and Web Development and Administration
- HCHS's 49% pass rate is their 2nd highest based on available data (55% in 2018) and an increase of 2% from 2021 and 19% from 2019 (HCHS did not test in 2020). 42 is by far the highest total number of students to pass and earn articulated credit (<u>https://education.ky.gov/CTE/ArtAgree/Pages/Art_Agree-EOP.aspx</u>) in a single year. Note that students were required previously to earn 3 credits in a pathway before becoming eligible to test. That has been reduced to 2 credits (to become a concentrator) and allows for more students to test.
- Culinary increased 17% over 2021 (67% / 50%)
- Marketing increased 18% over 2021 (43% / 25%)
- Horticulture decreased 19% from 2021 (14% / 33%) *Staff change
- Web Development and Administration decreased 11% from 2021 (64% / 75%) *Still exceeded state averages
- This is the first year an EOP has been available for **Mechanical Engineering**; congratulations on a 75% pass rate!
- Looking ahead to 2022-23, our goals are to meet or exceed averages for each pathway and the state as a whole.
