## Scoring Procedure for Informal Screening Measure #1 Circles Activity Page

The Circles Measure is scored using an adaptation of the four main criteria established by E. Paul Torrance for the Minnesota Tests of Creative Thinking.

## Fluency- number of responses

Flexibility- number of categories of thought as noted in the section on FLEXIBILITY Originality- number of original responses excluding those noted in ORIGINALITY Elaboration-each new and significant detail.

### FLUENCY-STOP AT 10. SCORE 10+ AS NEEDED.

- 1. DO score one point for each individual drawn response. Drawn responses may use one circle or more than one circle.
- Example: Eyeglasses are drawn using two circles. Score one point.

  Example: A bus drawn uses two circles for the wheels. Score one point.
- 2. DO score each circle that may contain only a scribble.
- 3. DO note the total score in the space provided on the child's activity page.

### FLEXIBILITY-STOP AT 10. SCORE 10+ AS NEEDED.

- 1. DO score one point for each different category referred to by a response as noted in the category list.
- 2. DO score one point for each category observed in the response as long as the category has not already been scored.
- 3. DO NOT score additional points if a category appears more than one time in the responses.
- 4. DO note the total score in the space provided on the child's activity page.
