Deadline: Wednesday April 15, 2021. Applications and required supporting documentation should be completed and returned to the <u>HCHS guidance office</u> by noon on Wednesday April 15, 2021.

Applicants will be judged on the following criteria: Promise as a Leader in the Job Field/Community, Defined College/Career Plans, Letters of Reference, High School Performance (ACT, GPA, and Rank).

Mission of Hope Scholarship

Pay special attention to the cover letter posted with the scholarship. Be sure to follow criteria for the application exactly as is stated on the cover letter. Due to the COVID 19 health crisis, Mission of Hope will not be conducting the usual Skype interviews they will be instead relying heavily on the personal letter that the student writes, it is important to be extremely detailed in your letter.

Criteria: It is the desire of the Mission of Hope that students with the <u>greatest</u> <u>financial need</u> be considered for the scholarships. Any student with a 2.5 GPA, and who demonstrates excellent potential and character, work experience, along with financial need may apply for this scholarship. One scholarship will be awarded to a student, the student must maintain an overall grade point average along with completing 12 credit hours per semester in order to keep the scholarship for the following semester.

Amount: \$2500.00.

Deadline: Applications must be returned to your high school counselor by noon on Monday March 1, 2021. Late applications will not be accepted.
